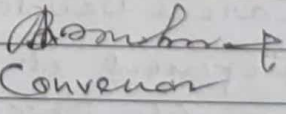

Dasatyajit Das.

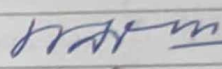
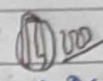
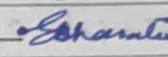
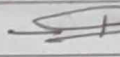
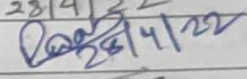
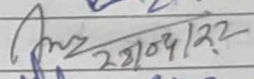
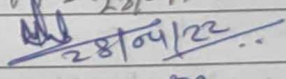
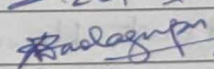
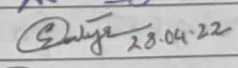

Report on the Programme

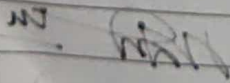

Report on CUET Guidance

From 23rd March 2023 to 1st April 2023, The Information Career Counselling and Student Progression Monitoring Committee of Lundin College organised a guidance Session for Common University Entrance Test on various Subjects. The Sessions aimed to provide Comprehensive information about CUET including its structure, eligibility criteria and preparation strategies.

The Session began with a overview of CUET, emphasizing its significance as a Common Entrance Test for admission to various undergraduate programmes in engineering and technology disciplines. The detailed Section information was provided about structure of CUET, including the number of Sections, types of questions and marking Schemes.
