Minutes of Today's meeting.

Today 28th April 2022, a meeting (General) was held by the Cultural Heritage Cell, IGAC Dumding College at Central Library of the College. The meeting started around 1.30 Pm with the conveners Dr. Indrajit Bezbarua and other six (6) members of the cell, whose details is noted on the left side of the page. The meeting was held to discuss on the formulations of the policy and programmes to be undertaken for existing sessions and upcoming sessions of the year.

Dr. Indrajit Bezbarua, suggested and proposed that in order to promote awareness to the students and other people on the need of conservation of Heritage buildings and sites of the locality and the country some steps should be taken. At first, the idea of preservation of chemistry building of the College was taken into concern as, it was that part of the College that has not being dismantled for new buildings, likewise the houses of Railway department also signified heritage buildings as it was built when the first Railway station was established at Dumdum. Sir proposed for holding a Poster making competition.

Dr. Jahnaki Das, also in the course of discussion proposed the Stone House at Haibang, though as it was not within the district, so the proposal for considering the location as Heritage site can only be forwarded.

Dr. Bandita Terangi, proposed the house for taking up long term project of 'documenting the cultural dance and costume of all indigenous tribal community

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living in Lunding area'. A video documentation was proposed, to which Dr. Indrajit proposed a dance workshop with the recordings.

Sri Bismajit Nath, proposed for holding a 'food exhibition of all indigenous communities' staying at Lunding locality which was actually a purpose for preservation of food habit of those indigenous group. In addition to this proposal, Dr. Indrajit proposed for 'Traditional cake exhibition' (Pithas of all communities of Lunding area.)

Dr. Akhil Ch. Kalita proposed for preservation of 'Traditional drink' (made out of rice) of different indigenous communities in written form.

Sri Bismajit and Dr. Indrajit simultaneously proposed for documenting and making models of various 'traditional youth dormitories' of different tribes.

Dr. Indrajit, along with the house discussed for a trip along with the students to nearby heritage sites viz. Nan Bhanga at Hojai for documentation if the budget permits.

Finally after general discussion, keeping in mind the probability, expenditure, and possibilities and outcome, four (4) programmes were finalised by the house to which the immediate programme is to hold a poster making competition with the theme "To identify and preserve the Historical sites of Assam" with in the May month. 2022.

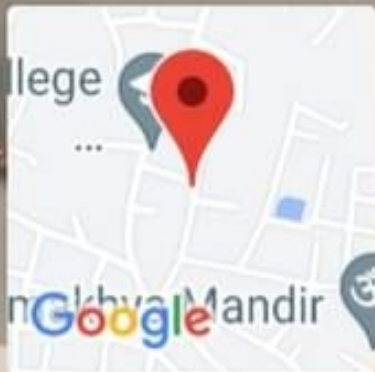
