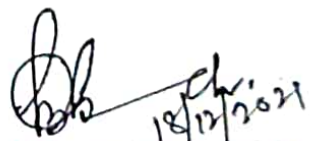
Discussion Points:

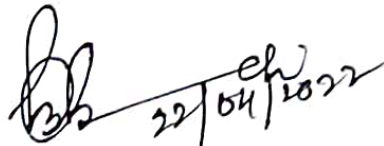
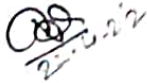

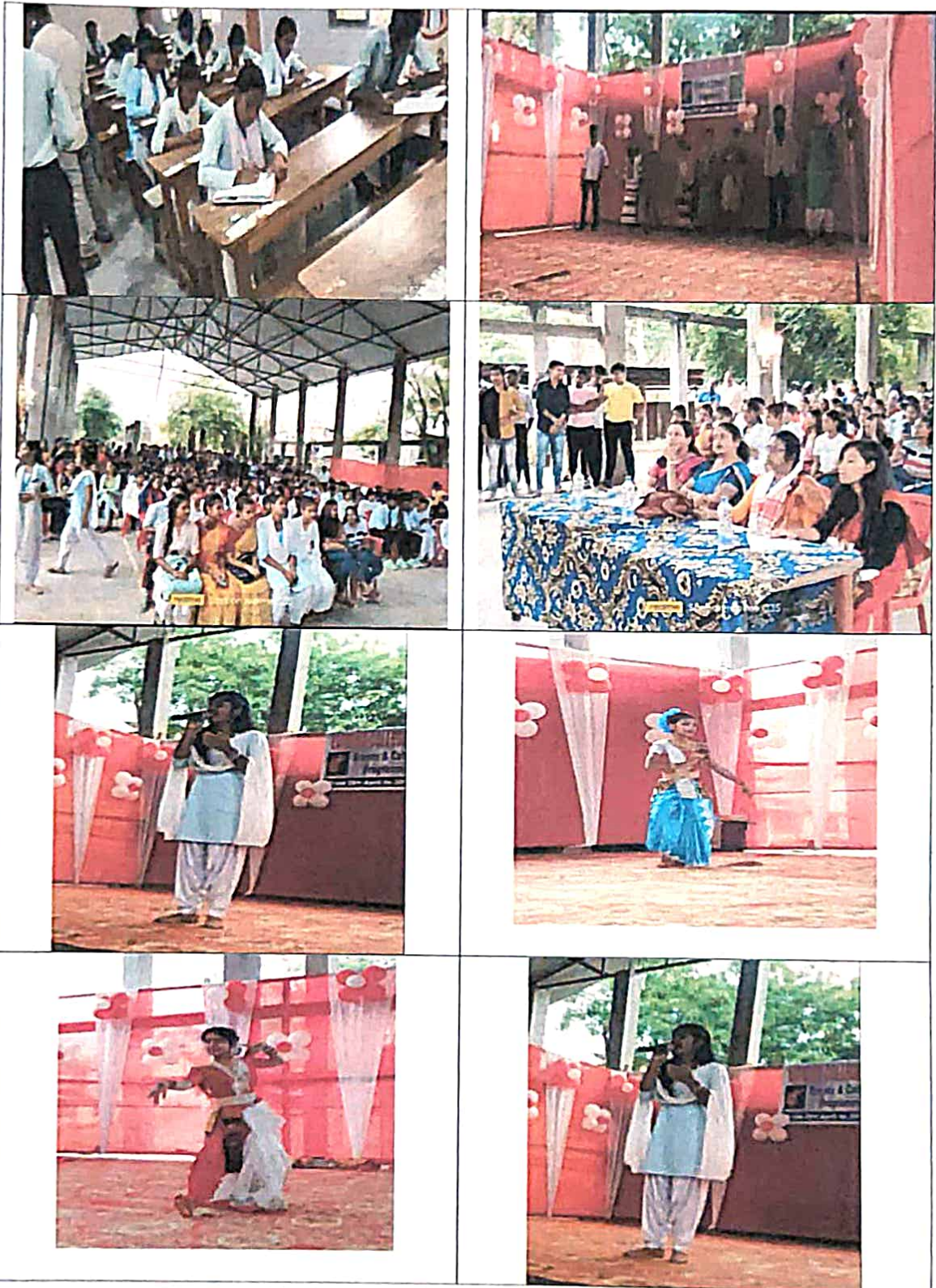
Picture: Dr. Paul, during the inaugural of the College Days, 2022

- Registration fees and other financial requirements to be submitted to the administration for approval by 15th February 2023.

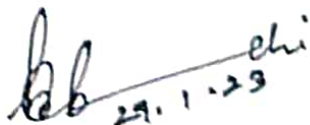
