Report on Remedial Coaching

Constituted by IQAC, the Remedial coaching committee monitors through its centralized mechanism the upliftment of the slow learners. The 3 member committee which comprises of a convener and two members directs all the Departments to sort out the slow learners on the basis of their performance in the sessional examination of each semester. The Departments are provided with centralized class schedule, earmarked for remedial classes along with exclusive attendance register for such students. Remedial Classes are held as per this schedule and their progress is tracked all along by the individual teacher-handling remedial classes. The Remedial coaching committee collects all records at regular intervals from the Departments and thus monitors the progress of the slow learners in the institution.

Report on Yoga and Meditation Training Programme

Yoga Workshop Cum Training Programme for 5 days (15th June to 19th June, 2017) is held in the Lumding College premises to participate in the centrally organised by 3rd International Yoga Day Celebration Committee, Lumding. A short programme is held in the College Conference Hall.

B.K. Mohan Singhal, Brahma Kumari, Mount Abu, is an M.Tech from Indian School of Mines (ISM), Dhanbad (1967). He joined ONGC in 1967 and served for 28 years in various capacities in Assam, Gujarat and Uttarakhand. He took voluntary retirement in 1996 while serving as Suptd. Geophysicist. He came in contact with the Brahma Kumaris in 1961 and since then, has remained an active member of the organization. Now, in Brahma Kumaris Ishwariya Vishwavidyalaya, he serves as the Member of Governing Body of Rajayoga Education and Research Foundation; Member of H.Q. Management Committee, National Coordinator of Scientists and Engineers Wing; Coordinator of Academy for a Better World Gyan Saorvar, Mount Abu; Editor of SEWs-NEWs, a Quaternary Publication of Scientists and Engineers Wing (SEW). He contributed a lot in Environmental Awareness Campaigns and Disaster Management Campaigns in India and Nepal. He is the recipient of Paryavaran Shree award by MHRD, 1992; International Award for Human Resource Development and Spiritual Development by International Association of Educators for World Peace (IAEWP), USA and Common Wealth Association for the Education and Training of Adults (CAETA), uk in 2004.

Distinguished guests were B.K. Arjun and B.K. Kalpana. After felicitation programme, convener, Value Education Committee, Sanghamitra Das Bose briefly explained the aim of the workshop. School and college students come from diverse backgrounds having diverse mentality. To build up the harmonious relationship between teachers and students, students with fellow students and workers and their colleagues, meditation can take a vital role. The resource person strongly explained how harmonious relationship is the prime necessity in the work places. He involved the participants by different techniques, adopting using visual aids. Eg. Powerpoint presentation. He also taught different meditation techniques and made the workshop successful. Total no. of participants were 49 including students, teachers and office staff.

Workshop on "**Science and Spirituality**" is held at Lumding College Library Reading Room on 12/12/2014 at 11 am. Members of Lumding College again feels honoured having B.K. Mohan Singhal among them as Recourse Person. In general perspective, science and spirituality are poles apart. But how life's vital processes are run by science and enriched by spirituality has been clearly and thoroughly explained by the honourable resource person. The Value Education Committee collaborated with Prajapita Brahmakumaris to organise this event. 50 participants took part in this workshop including students, teachers and non-teaching staff of the college. Other speakers, B.K. Arjuna and B.K. Kalpana briely added to the topic.

Special talk on " **Secret to Happiness**" was organised by Value Education Committee, Lumding College, Lumding. Resource person, Sri Vishnu Prakash, full time Art of Living Teacher. He is the founder director at sridhenu.org. and NGO for social upliftment. Before dedicating his life completely to the Art of Living , he served as a

veteran software developer at Microsoft. Inspired by Gurudev Sri Sri Ravishankar, he came to know that teaching was his calling and he has been into it ever since then. He has been conducting AOL workshops at IITs, ISB , IIIT, Banking Corporates, Central Prisons and remote villages of Assam and Northeast for the last 7 years. He also leads a research wing at Sridhenu about indigenous cow therapy. His talks revolve around the ways to be happy. Happiness is the basic mental need of every human being. But, due to stress, anxiety and the fast lifestyle, mentally and physically, all are tired with a distorted lifestyle. Practising meditation is not so easy for general people. But the specially designed 'Sudarshan Kriya' by the holiness Gurudev Sri Sri Ravishankar has successfully met the vision of making meditation a universally accessible process. This technique circumscribes all the dimensions of existence and does the job of bringing them in harmonious balance with each other. His speech motivated a batch of 38 participants. Report on language lab.

A digitalized language Laboratory setup in the college has been providing variety of courses dealing with basic skills in language learning process . A 15 seater lab has a LAN to establish link between the learners and the teacher. Each seat with desktop PC and head phone helps to integrate Text, images, audio and video. Teachers can alter materials to fit their requirements. Learners can record their own voice and playback the recordings, interact with each other and the teacher and store results. Teachers can intervene and control the learner's computer after completion of the registration process, via the teacher's console, track of learners' work etc.

The Department of English makes use of the lab for the utmost benefit of students who have opted for Major course in English. Students of B.Sc. who have Functional English as part of their syllabus and the students of B.Com who have Communicative and Functional English in their course of study also make use of the Lab. Besides , the department of English aims at offering crash courses on

Language learning such as English speaking Courses, pronunciation skills, phonetic transcription etc. The department also aims at equipping the lab with latest updates on language skills through its installed software.
