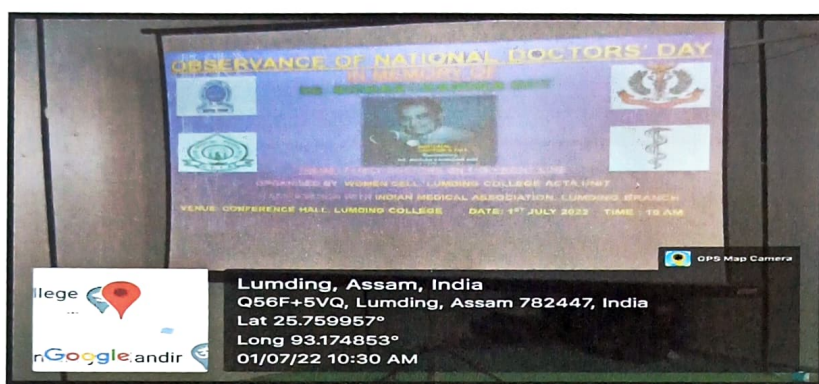




REPORT OBSERVANCE OF NATIONAL DOCTORS' DAY, 2022.

Every year 1st of July is celebrated as National Doctors' Day in India on the birth and death anniversary of Dr. Bidhan Chandra Roy, in order to honour and remember his contribution to the society and also to acknowledge the contribution of all doctors to mankind. The Women Cell, ACTA Unit, Lumding College too observed the National Doctors' Day on 1st July, 2022. This programme was held in association with Indian Medical Association, Lumding branch. The main objective behind organizing this programme was to give free health check-up (mainly anemia test) to the students of the college. For that matter, Dr. Sumitra Dey-Deputy Superintendent, Dr. Bidhan Dutta-Medical Officer, two staff nurses-Dikshita Sharma and Madhusmita Rajbongshi, Uttam Rai Chowdhury-Lab technician, Mridul Das- Computer Assistant and Murli Rao- OT boy from Lumding FRU were invited.



The programme started at 10:00 am in the conference hall of the college. At first there was ceremonial lighting of the lamp after which the Principal of the College, Dr. Mrinal Kanti Paul and all the other guests were invited on the stage and duly felicitated.

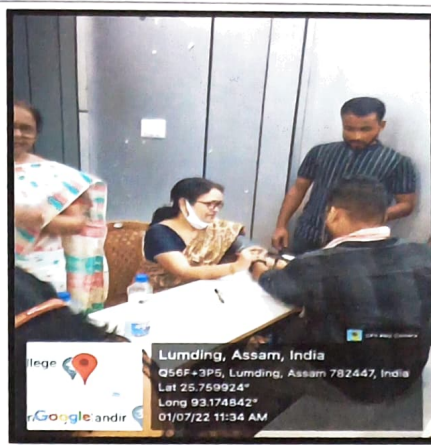
