



TRAINING PROGRAMME FOR STUDENT VERIFIERS OF THE ORUNODOI BENEFICIARIES OF HOJAI DISTRICT

Orunodoi or Arunodoi Scheme is a new scheme under the Government of Assam that was launched on 2nd October 2020 which envisages providing financial help to more than 24 lakh poor household in the state. In view of attainment of this objective, a letter from the Director of Higher Education had been sent to the Principals of government and provincialized colleges to deploy students and carry out surveys. The letter mentioned that preference should be given to students with NCC/NSS backgrounds while selecting members of the survey teams. Furthermore, the letter also suggested that two teams with two members each will be constituted for each gaon panchayat area. In compliance with this order from the State government of Assam to deploy college students to carry out house-to-house surveys of beneficiaries of the Orunodoi scheme from August 1 to ascertain their economic status, Lumding College conducted a training session of 70 undergraduate students on 2nd August, 2022 in the conference hall of the college.

Sri G.C. Bharna, ADC of Hojai and Sri Dharani Das, District Manager of DITEC, Hojai were invited as the master trainers of the programme. The selection of the students to carry out the surveys was arranged and monitored by the NSS and Extension Activities Cell, IQAC, Lumding College. Teachers and other officials who are appointed as supervisors also attended the programme.





The programme started at 11:00 am in the conference hall of the college. There was a brief address by the Principal of the college, Dr. Mrinal Kanti Paul at the onset. After that Sri G.C. Bharna proceeded with the training process of the selected students. He explained the objectives behind the Orunodoi scheme and chalked out the strategies to follow to conduct the surveys of the beneficiaries. After that Sri Dharani Das also extensively explained how to conduct the surveys successfully and various other matters related to the scheme. There was also an interactive session between the trainers and the selected students. The training session ended at 12:30 pm. Ten faculties and eighty students attended the programme.
