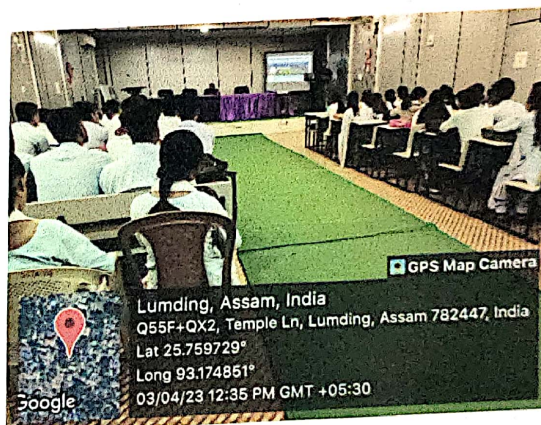
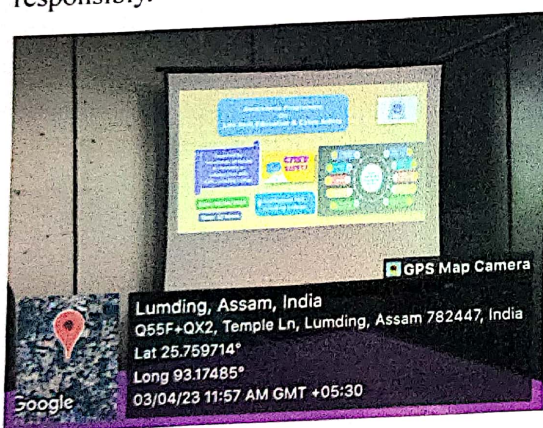


Report on Awareness Programme on Life Skill Education and Cyber Safety

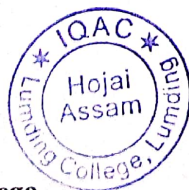
