

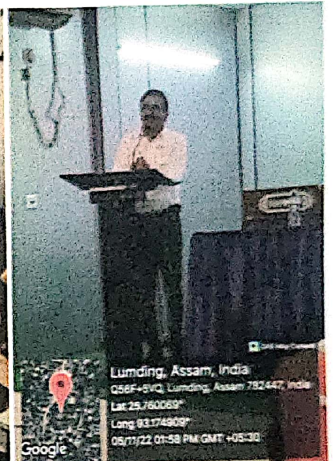
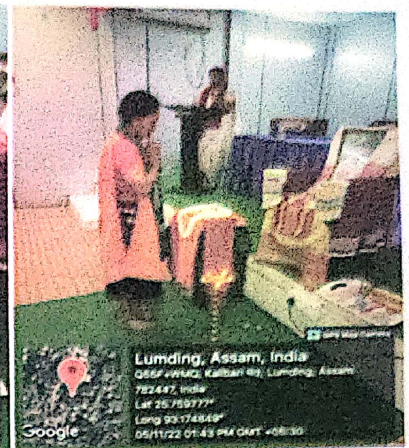
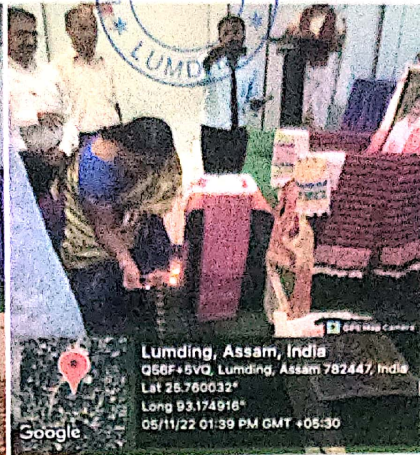
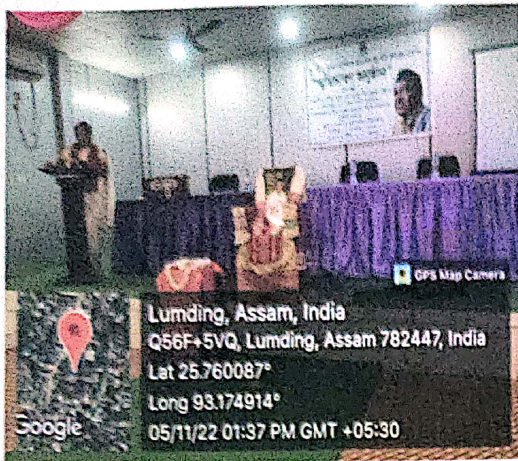


REPORT ON OBSERVANCE OF DEATH ANNIVERSARY OF SUDHAKANTHA DR. BHUPEN HAZARIKA

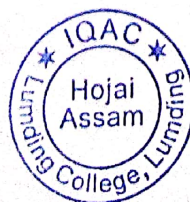
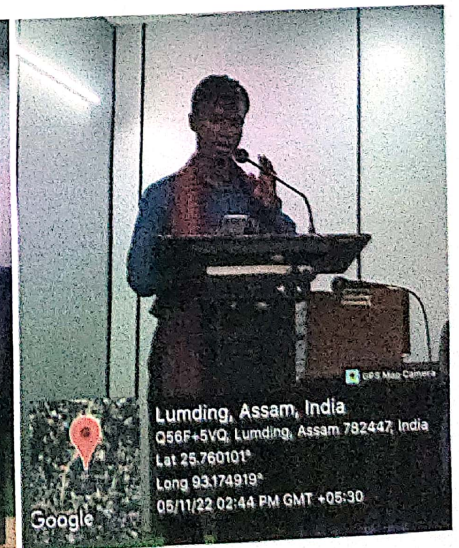
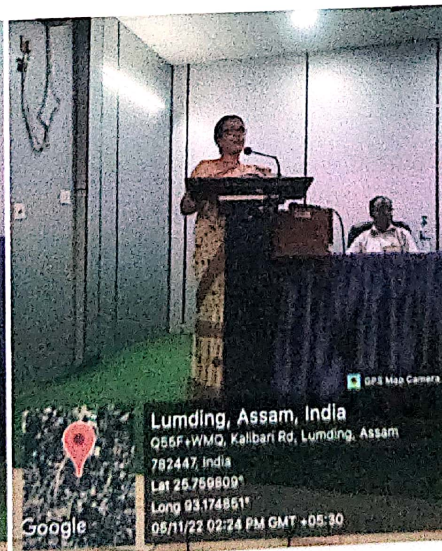

Picture: Moments from the inauguration programme



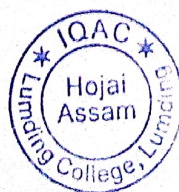


Picture: Participants during their performances.
