Seminar on Employment Oriented Courses at North East Skill Centre



A seminar on "Employment Oriented Courses at North East Skill Centre" was organised in Lumding College by Career Counseling, Student Progression and Monitoring Cell, IQAC, Lumding College in collaboration with North East Skill Centre on **6th April, 2019**. It is a part of Assam Skill Development Mission under the Skill India flagship of Government of India. The seminar began at 11 a.m. in the college seminar hall.
