Workshop on Career Development, Interview Challenges and Skill Development

A career development workshop entitled "Career Development, Interview Challenges and Skill Development" was held in Lumding College, organised by IQAC, Lumding College on **6th December, 2018**. The resource person of the program was from Kajiranga University, Assam. The program was started at 11.00 a.m. by the felicitation of invitee and lighting of the lamp, following which Dr. Mrinal Kanti Paul, Principal, Lumding College delivered his inauguration speech welcoming everyone to the program. Dr. Paul mentioned that such programs were the need of the hour in order to enhance the students' skill and make them placement ready. Next, IQAC coordinator Sri S. K. Jha, who is also an Associate Professor, Department of Mathematics, emphasized the importance of such workshops and was hopeful that students would be benefited from it. Followed by Sri Jha's speech, the resource person started his session. In the first half of his session, he mainly focused on how to choose a right career option depending on a person's personality profile, strength and values. He then talked about different skills such as written communication, oral communication, leadership, problem solving, critical thinking, creative thinking, team work, etc. that the employers seek in an employee depending on the job profile. He said that all these skills could be developed and excelled. In the second half of his session, he dealt with how to write curriculum vitae (CV) and cover letter professionally. He also discussed different ways to improve oral communication skills, interpersonal skill and analytical thinking from the point of view of interview. At the end of the session, the students interacted with the resource person where he addressed their queries related to the theme. Lastly, Dr. Manash Mazumder, Assistant Professor, Department of History, delivered the valedictory speech where he extended heartfelt gratitude to the organising committee, the resource person, the faculty members and the students of the Lumding College for their corporation during the workshop. Thus, the workshop successfully came to an end with the participation of 12 faculty members and 150 students.



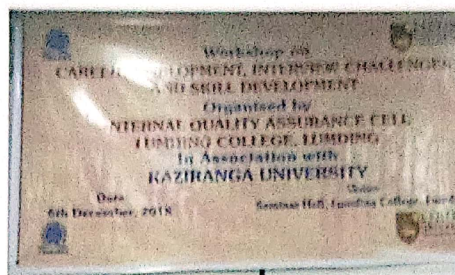
