The NSS and Extension Activity Cell in association with IQAC, Lumding College, organized a webinar to celebrate World Food Safety Day on 7th of June, 2023. Food safety is a shared responsibility between governments, producers and consumers. Everybody has a role to play from farm to table to ensure the food we consume is safe and will not cause damages to our health. Through the World Food Safety Day, WHO pursues its efforts to mainstream food safety in the public agenda and reduce the burden of foodborne diseases globally. This year the theme for World Food Safety Day was "Food Standards Save Lives."

The webinar started at 7:00 pm on Google Meet. The inaugurator of the webinar was Dr. Mrinal Kanti Paul, Principal, Lumding College, the moderator was Mr. Anjan Paul, Assistant professor from the Department of Bengali, who is also the Programme coordinator of the NSS and Extension Activity Cell, and student moderator was Mangal Seal, Representative officer NSS Unit, Lumding College.

The key speaker of the webinar was Mr. Saleh Akram, Assistant Professor from the Department of Botany, Lumding College. At the outset of his address to the audience, he briefly explained the reason why the day is celebrated- to spread awareness about foodborne hazards.

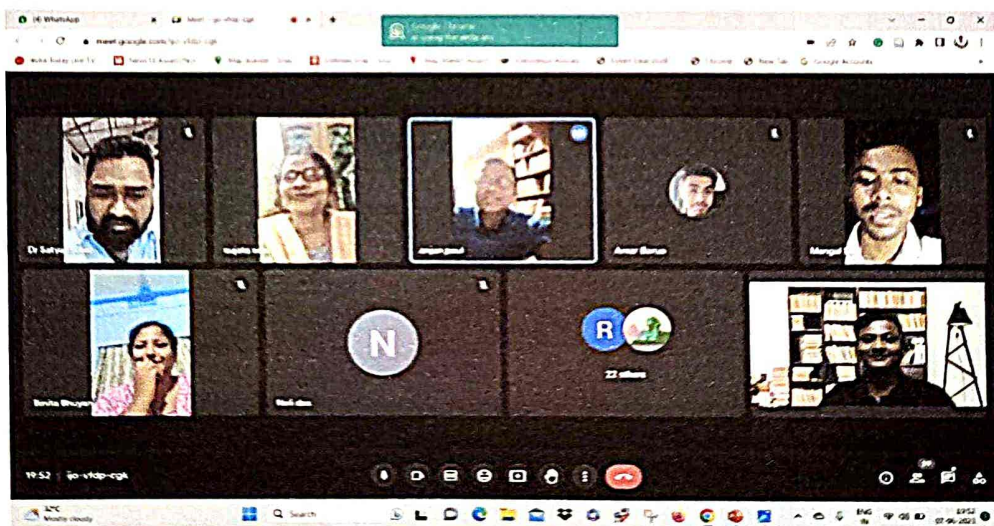


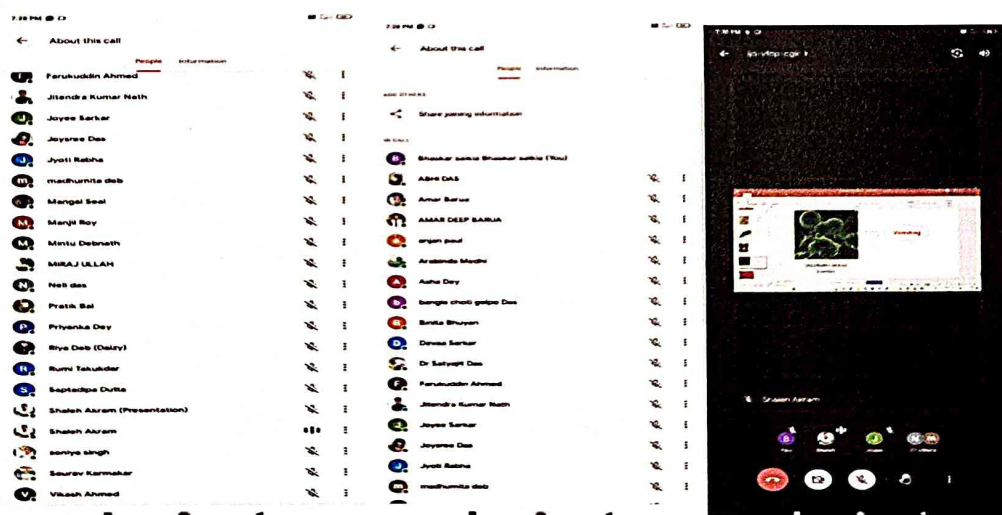
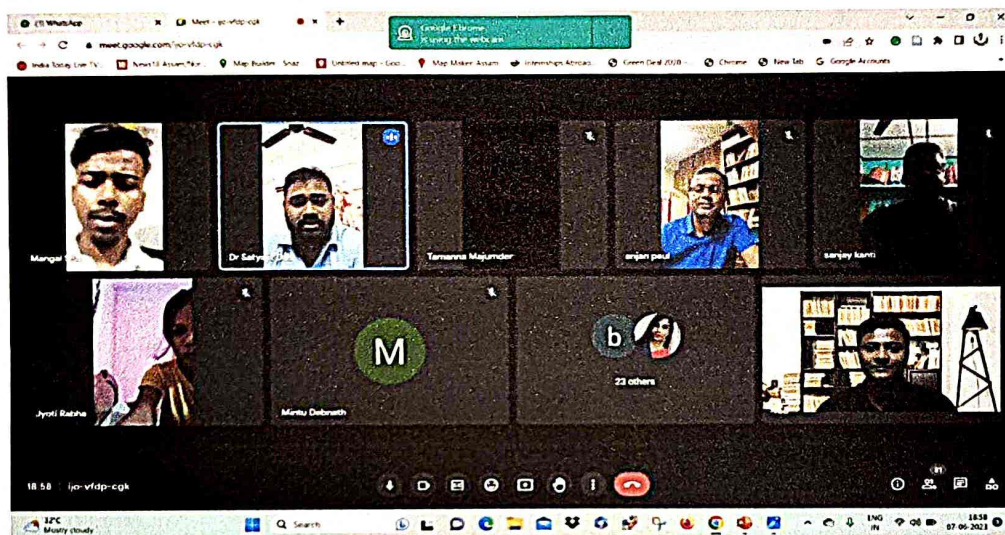
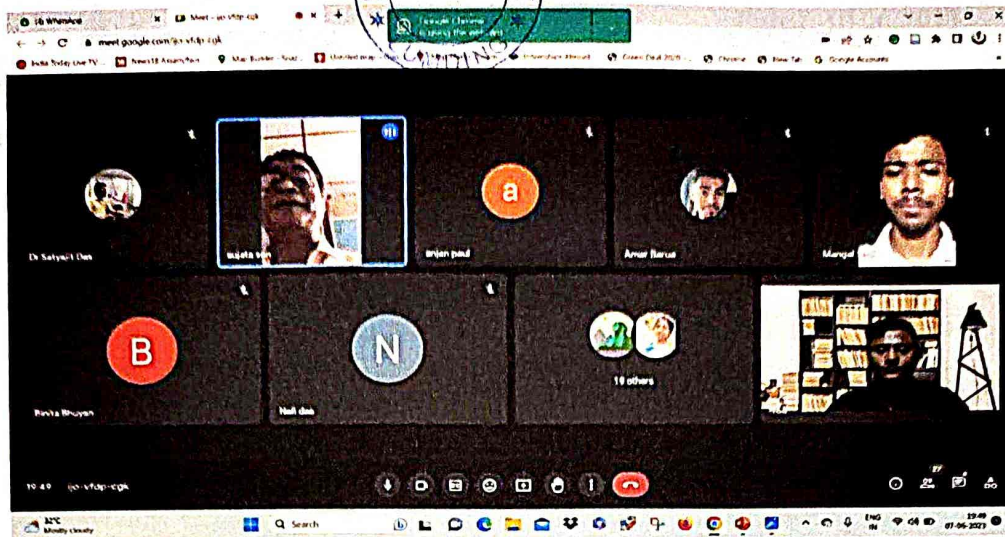


In 2018, the United Nations General Assembly named June 7 World Food Safety Day. The motive of celebrating this day is to make people aware of and take action with regard to prevention, detection and management of foodborne diseases and risks. Further, in his speech, Mr. Saleh Akram, explained how ensuring food safety is often taken for granted. Then he highlighted the importance of this year's theme saying **"Food Standards Save Lives"** highlights the need of sustainable production systems to ensure the health of people, the planet and the economy in the long-term. It is important to recognize that the health of people, animals, and the environment is interconnected and that any Safety adverse event may have a global impact on public health, trade and economy. He ended his speech by saying how food safety is a shared responsibility between governments, producers and consumers. Everybody has a role to play from farm to table to ensure the food we consume is safe and will not cause damages to our health.

His speech was followed by a speech by Dr. Satyajit Das, Assistant Professor from the Department of Zoology and another by Dr. Sujata Sen, Assistant Professor from the Department of Geology. Both of them highlighted the importance behind celebration of the day and also urged every individual to actively participate in the World Food Safety Day Campaigns to ensure that their food is safe. Food Safety teaches everyone to conserve food, not to waste it. The programme ended with a Vote of Thanks by Mr. Anjan Paul, Programme coordinator of the NSS and Extension Activity Cell, where he thanked everyone for their active participation and coordination.
