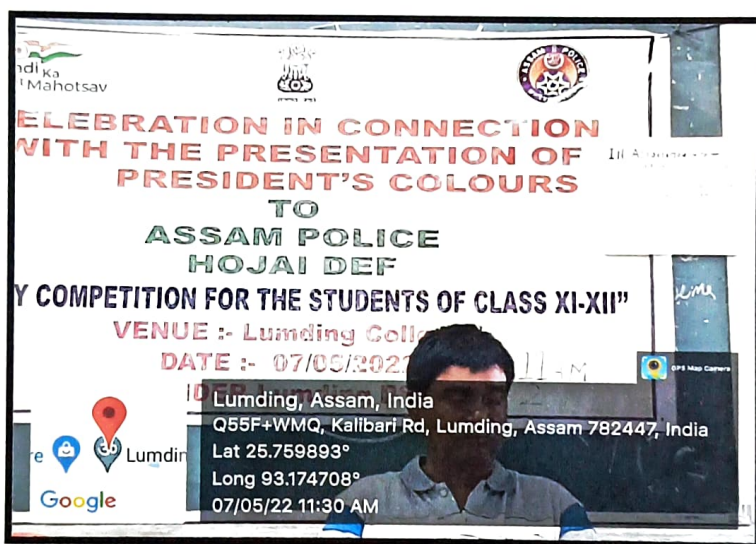


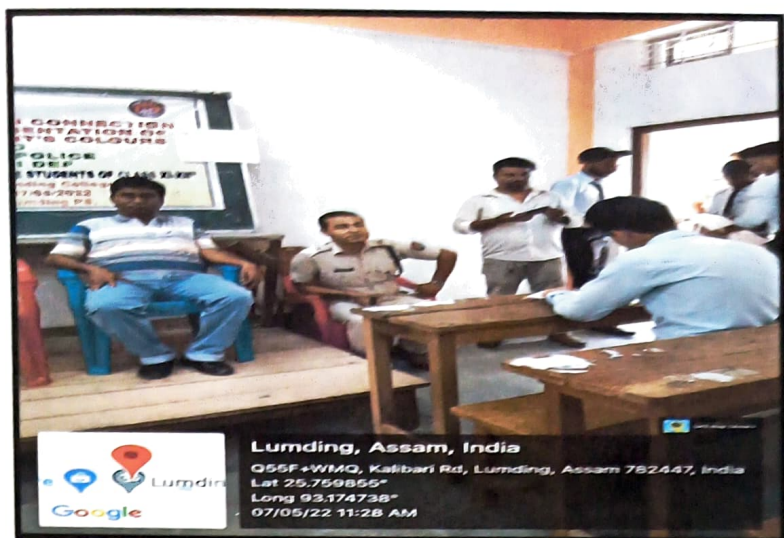

The flag is engraved with Assam's map and 36 stars representing the districts of the state, a one-horned rhino and the insignia of Assam Police with its motto. Assam is the 10th state in the country to receive the President's Colour, the highest honour given to any military or police unit in recognition of exceptional service rendered to the nation, both in peace and war. In this connection, as a part of the celebration, the Lumding Police Station organized an essay competition in association with the Cultural and Literary Committee (IQAC), Lumding College on the 7th of May, 2022.
