



REPORT ON AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON REVISED ACCREDITATION FRAMEWORK OF NATIONAL ASSESSMENT AND ACCREDITATION COUNCIL (NAAC)

NAAC accreditation is very essential for promoting quality education at graduation and post-graduation levels. The UGC regulation has made NAAC accreditation mandatory to foster and encourage self-evaluation, accountability, autonomy and innovations in the higher education institutions so that a high level of quality can be achieved in teaching, learning and research.
