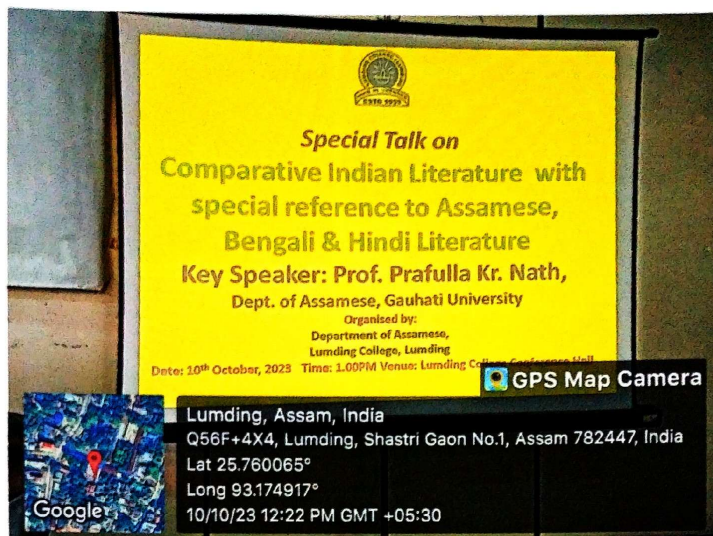




Report on*

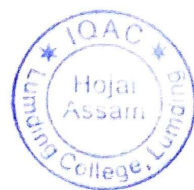
