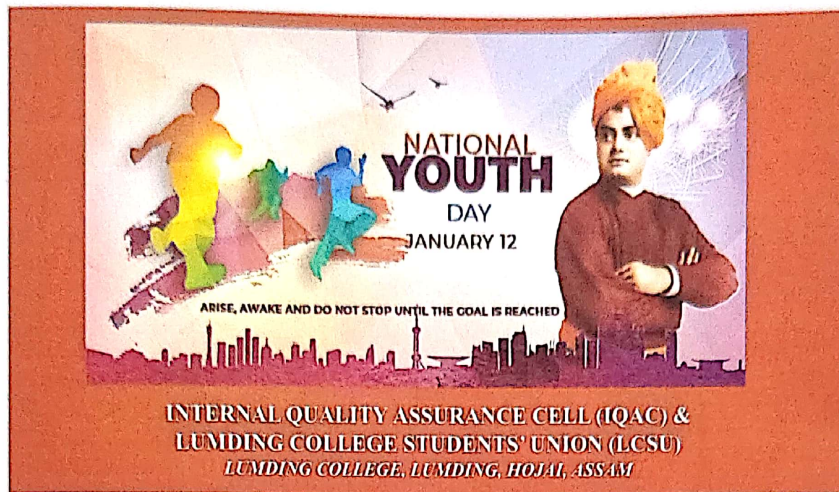




REPORT ON **OBSERVANCE OF NATIONAL YOUTH DAY-2018**



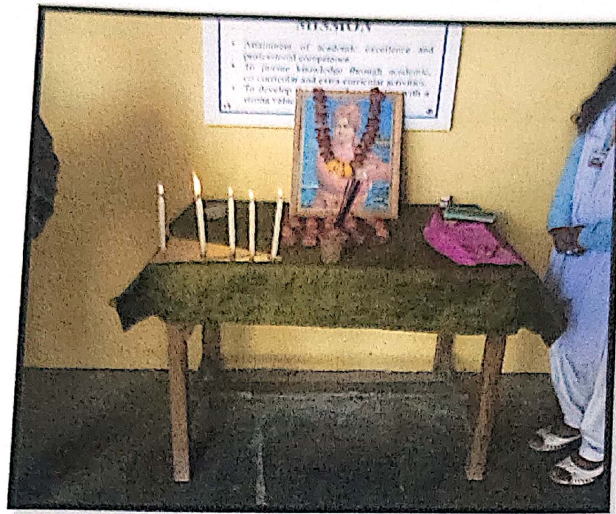

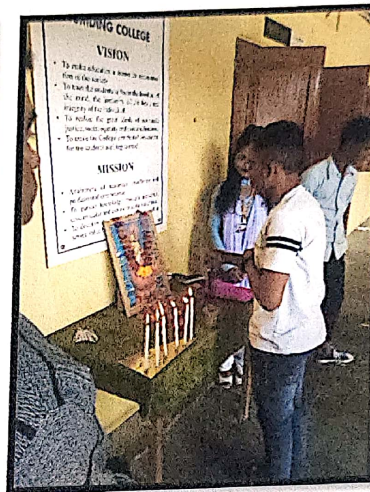
The programme ended with a vote of thanks extended by Sri Anjan Paul, Assistant Professor, Department of Bengali.
