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RAKSHA BANDHAN CELEBRATION



Raksha Bandhan is a popular Hindu ceremony that is celebrated on the last day of the Hindu lunar calendar month of Shraavana. On this day, sisters of all ages tie a talisman or amulet called the *Rakhi* around the wrists of their brothers. This symbolically invests the brothers with a share of the responsibility of protecting and taking care of their sisters. On 12th August, 2022, Lumding College Students' Union (LCSU) celebrated Raksha Bandhan with great pomp and show in a view to spread a sense of brotherhood among the habitants of Lumding. The celebration began by tying Rakhi on the hands of the Principal of Lumding College, Dr. Mrinal K. Paul.
