

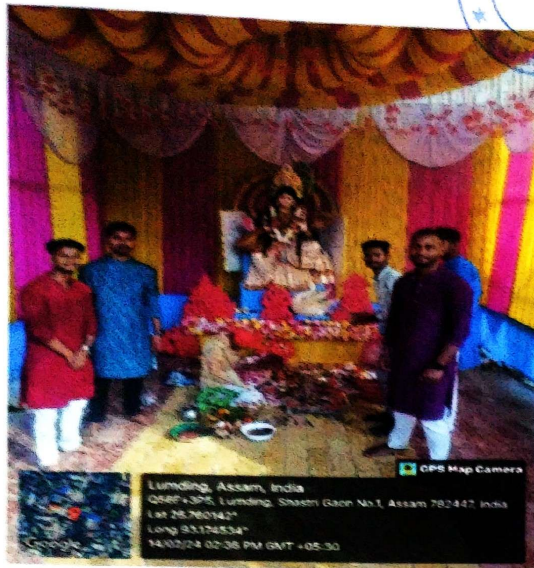


Report on the Celebration of Saraswati Puja

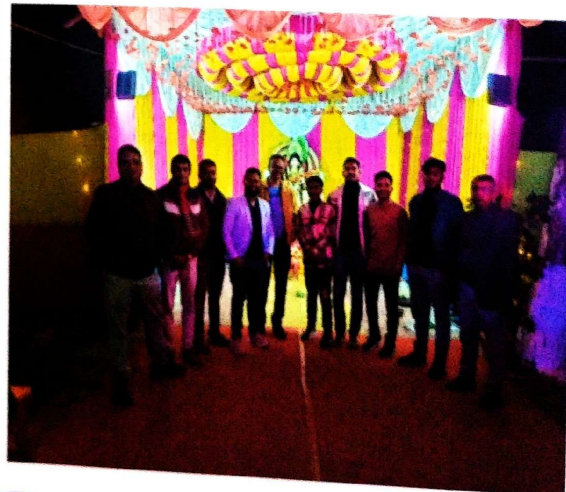
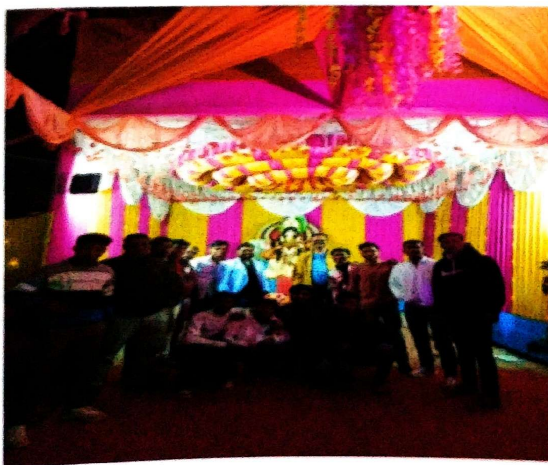

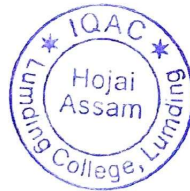
