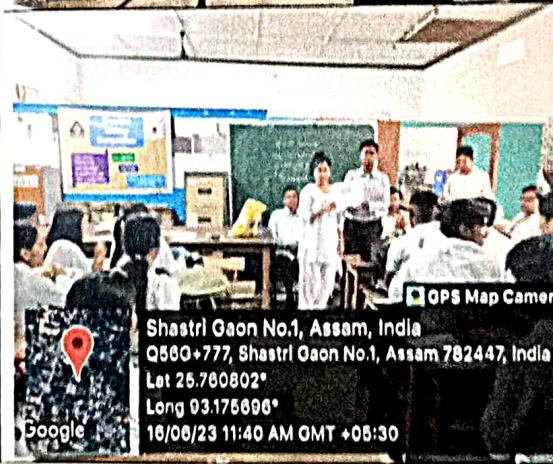
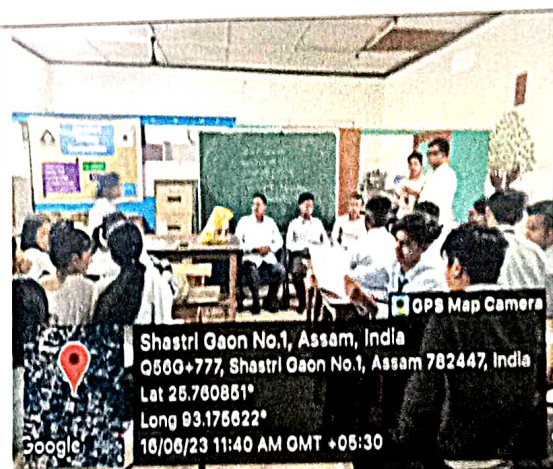
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A two-day hands-on training cum workshop on Beekeeping for Sustainable Livelihood was conducted at the seminar hall of Lumding College, Lumding by the Botany department in collaboration with IQAC, Lumding College on 15th and 16th of June 2023 which aimed to educate participants about the crucial role of beekeeping in fostering sustainable development. The resource person for this workshop was a renowned apiologist and retired curator, Dr. Gajen Chandra Sarma, Professor, Dept. of Botany, Gauhati University.

On the initial day of the workshop, the program commenced at 11:00 am which began with a formal introduction of the resource person in presence of the principal, Dr. Mrinal Kanti Paul, IQAC coordinator, Dr. Sanjay Kanti Das, Mr. Nirmalya Shekhar Singha Choudhury, head in the department of Botany, Lumding College and other faculties of the college. Mr. Rantumoni Sarma, assistant professor, Botany dept had hosted the event where the participants included students from the Botany department. On the first day, the technical session covered theoretical aspects of beekeeping, including discussions on its economic significance, bee culture techniques, disease control measures, and methods for harvesting and processing honey and wax. The second day took place in the botanical garden of Lumding College which was on the practical demonstration of handling of bee box with live bees. There were 20 participants and this workshop provided attendees with insights into the environmental, economic, and social benefits of beekeeping practices. The event concluded with a vote of thanks delivered by Mr. Shalch Akram, assistant professor, Botany department.
