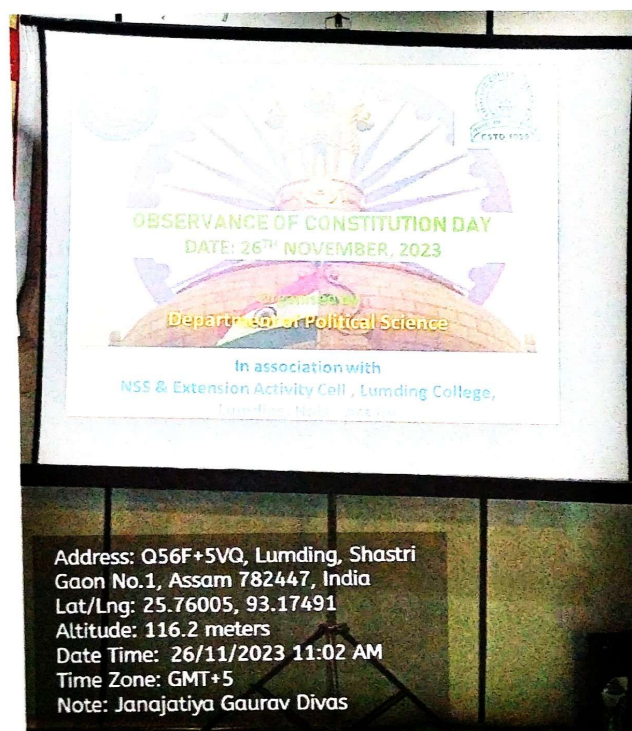


**Report on Observance of Constitution Day and Celebration of
Jan Jatiya Gaurav Diwas, 2023 from 15th November to 26th
November, 2023**



India's Constitution was adopted on November 26, 1949, and came into effect on January 26, 1950. Government of India in 2015 decided to observe 26th November as 'Constitution Day' or 'Samvidhan Divas'. In this regard, a communication has been received from UGC to celebrate 'Indian Constitution Day' on 26th November, 2020. In response to UGC letter No. 2-68/2023(CPP-II) dated 21.11.2023 and 24th November 2023 regarding Celebration of Constitution Day, also known as Samvidhan Divas which is celebrated in India on 26th November every year to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India. Besides highlighting and reaffirming the ideas and principles it upholds and honour and acknowledge the contribution of our Founding Fathers.



The programme started with a patriotic song, Lighting of Lamps followed by welcome address by Dr. Sanjay Kanti Das, IQAC Coordinator, Lumding College. 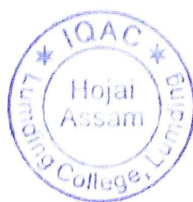
