

Research Methodology Workshop



A week-long Research Methodology workshop took place at Lumding College from 17th to 22nd April 2023, organized by the Research and Development Cell in collaboration with IQAC, Lumding College. The inaugural session on 17th April commenced with lighting of the ceremonial lamp. Dr. Mrinal Kanti Paul, the Principal of Lumding College, delivered an insightful address, setting the tone for the workshop. Dr. Phatik Tamuli, Principal of Lanka College, also shared valuable perspectives, emphasizing the significance of research in academic pursuits. All about 182 participants attend the workshop of the 37 belongs to faculties of Lumding college and other neighbouring institutions.

The technical sessions began in the afternoon with Dr. Sandip Ratna, Associate Professor from the Department of Mathematics at State College of Teacher Education, Kohima, serving as the resource person. Dr. Ratna delved into the fundamentals of research, covering topics such as research methods, measurement, and hypothesis formulation, providing participants with a robust foundation in research methodology.

On 18th April, the first session was conducted by Dr. Jayanta Mitra, Associate Professor from the Department of Botany at Arunachal University of Studies, focusing on research ethics and plagiarism. Following this, Miss Shilpisikha Baruah, Assistant Professor from the Department of History at Lanka Mahavidyalaya, elucidated on the essentials of research and literature review, enriching participants' understanding of scholarly inquiry.

Dr. Ajit Debnath from the Department of Economics at MSSV, Nagaon, led the first session on 19th April, shedding light on measurement techniques and hypothesis testing. In the subsequent session, Dr. Amulya Ch. Barman, a retired Professor from the Department of Hindi at Cotton University, provided valuable insights into research methodologies in Hindi literature, offering a specialized perspective to participants.

Dr. Jyoti Sanyal, Assistant Professor at Assam University, Diphu Campus, guided attendees through different research methodologies on 20th April, broadening their awareness of diverse approaches to inquiry. Dr. Jayanta Barman, Associate Professor at ADP College, Nagaon, then facilitated a session on research report writing, equipping participants with essential skills for effective dissemination of research findings.

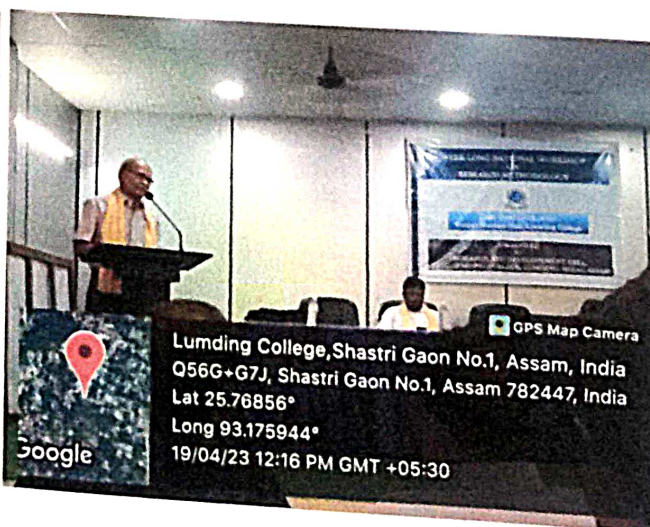
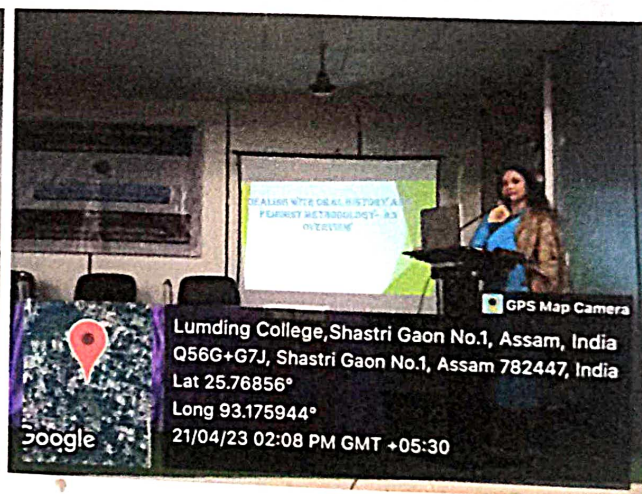
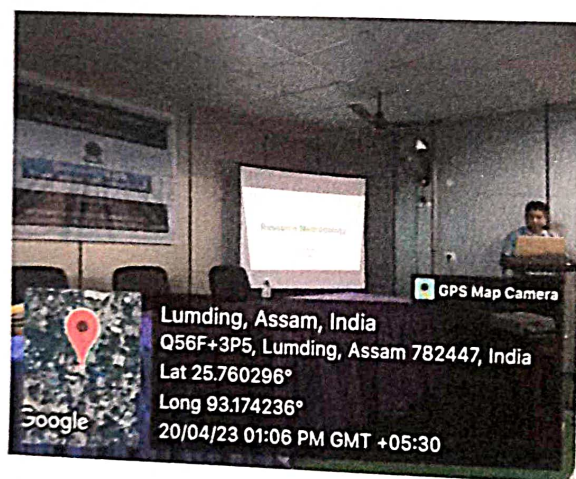


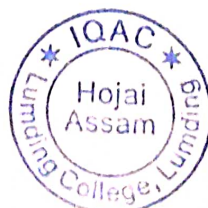
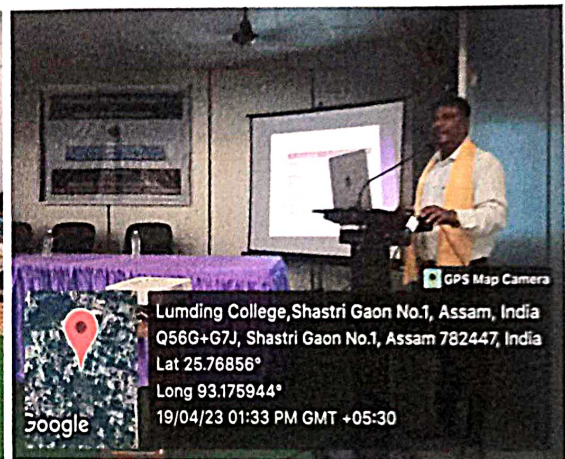


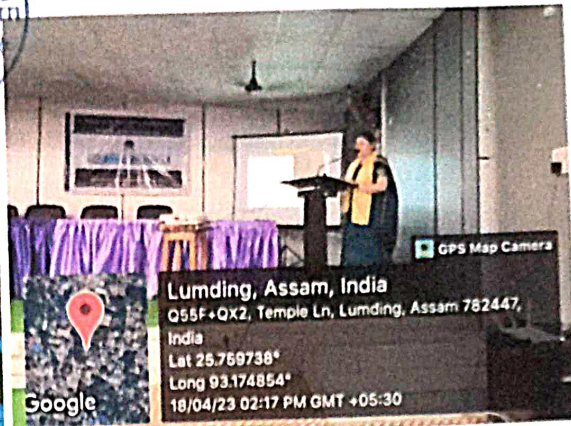
