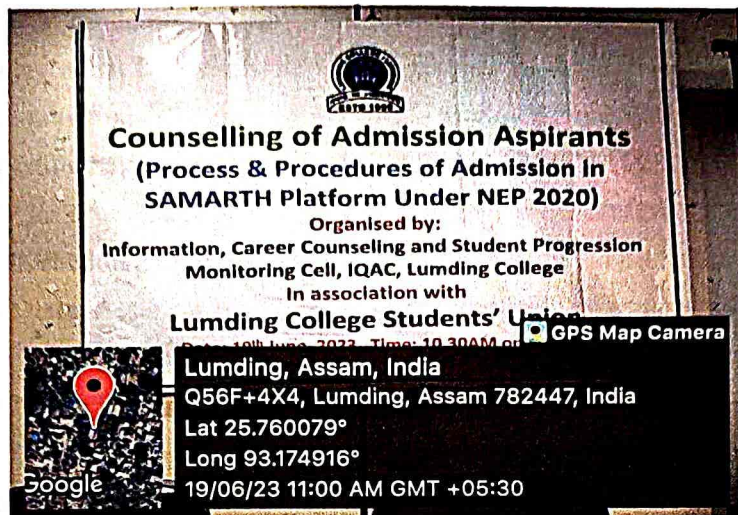




Report on
