INAUGURAL CEREMONY OF PROMOTIONAL PROGRAMME ON INDIA'S Y20 SUMMIT DURING G20 PRESIDENCY

As directed by the District Administration, Hojai, a promotional programme on India's Y20 summit during India's G20 presidency was observed at Lumding College- a collective initiative in association with IQAC, Lumding College from 20th to 27th January, 2023. Various competitions and programmes had been lined up as a part of the promotional programme.

On the first day, that is, on 20th January, 2023, an inauguration programme was organized followed by a workshop on 'The Shift from Job Seekers to Self-employed Entrepreneurs and Job Creators', where Mr. Ranjan K. Baruah, a Career Mentor cum Skill Trainer, had been invited as the resource person. The programme held at the conference hall of the college began at 11:30 am in the presence of students as well as faculty members.

Dr. Bandita Teronpi, from the Department of Political Science anchored the programme. At first, there was the ceremonial lighting of the lamp, followed by the formation of the dais.

Baruah were invited on the stage to take their respective seats, followed by which they were felicitated with the Assamese traditional gamusa. Next, Dr. Mrinal Kanti Paul, was called forward to deliver the welcome speech on the occasion. Dr. Paul welcomed everyone





and thanked the resource person for gracing the event with his presence. He briefed on the Y20 summit and also added how it is a unique opportunity to allow the youth to provide constructive policy inputs and to utilize the platform to voice their opinions for the world audience.

He elaborated on Y20 summit and explained how it is one of the eight official engagement groups under the G20 umbrella. The youth summit usually takes place some weeks prior to the traditional forum to know what the youths are thinking and incorporate their suggestions in their own policy proposals. He also added and informed the audience that this year the central event of the Y20 summit will be held in IIT-Guwahati where a total of 400 participants, including prize winners of competitions from various university/college, will participate. He therefore encouraged the students to participate in the upcoming quiz and debate competitions held as a part of the programme.

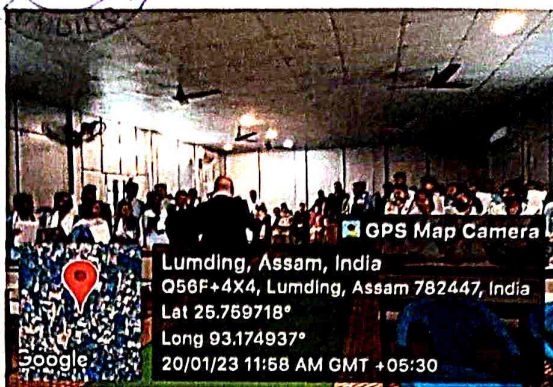
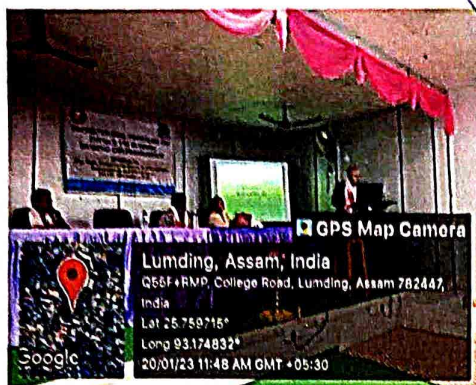
