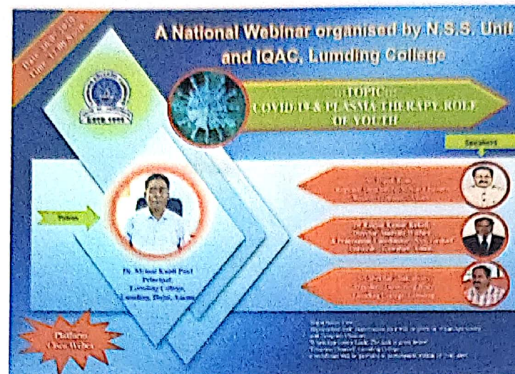


Webinar on Covid-19 & Plasma Therapy-Role of Youth



The NSS unit of Lumding College in collaboration with IQAC, Lumding College, organized a webinar on Covid-19 & Plasma Therapy and the role of youths in providing support to health departments. The webinar was held online via Cisco Webex platform on 20th July, 2020 at 12:00 noon. Dr. Mrinal Kanti Paul, Principal of Lumding college, initiated the session with a short welcome speech.
