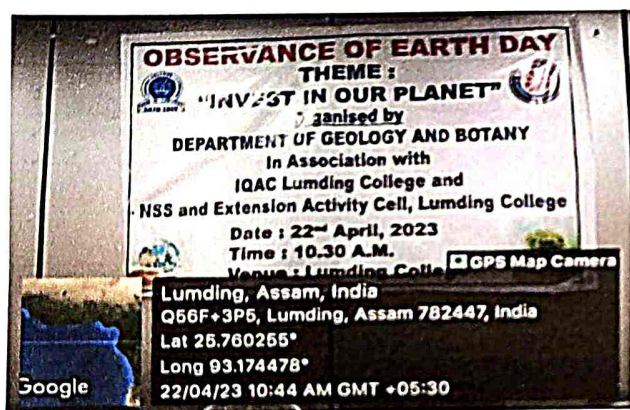


Report on Observance of Earth Day

On April 22, 2023, the Department of Geology and the Department of Botany, in collaboration with NSS and Extension Activity Cell, IQAC, Lumding College, organized the World Earth Day with a series of events aimed at raising awareness about environmental conservation and sustainable practices. The theme of this year's World Earth Day was "Invest in Our Planet." The celebration commenced at 10.30 a.m. in the college seminar hall. Dr. Mrinal K. Paul, Principal, Lumding College inaugurated the program by a welcome speech in which he focuses on the the significance of Earth Day. Following his speech, Nirmalya S Singh Choudhury, Head of Department of Botany, Lumding College and Dr. Sanjay K. Das, Coordinator, IQAC, Lumding College delivered their insightful talks emphasizing the importance of preserving our planet's natural resources. Following the lecture session, a plantation drive was conducted in the college premises and the Girls' Hostel of Lumding College. 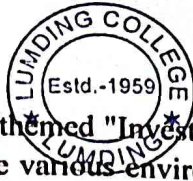


Picture: World Earth Day celebration at the college seminar hall.

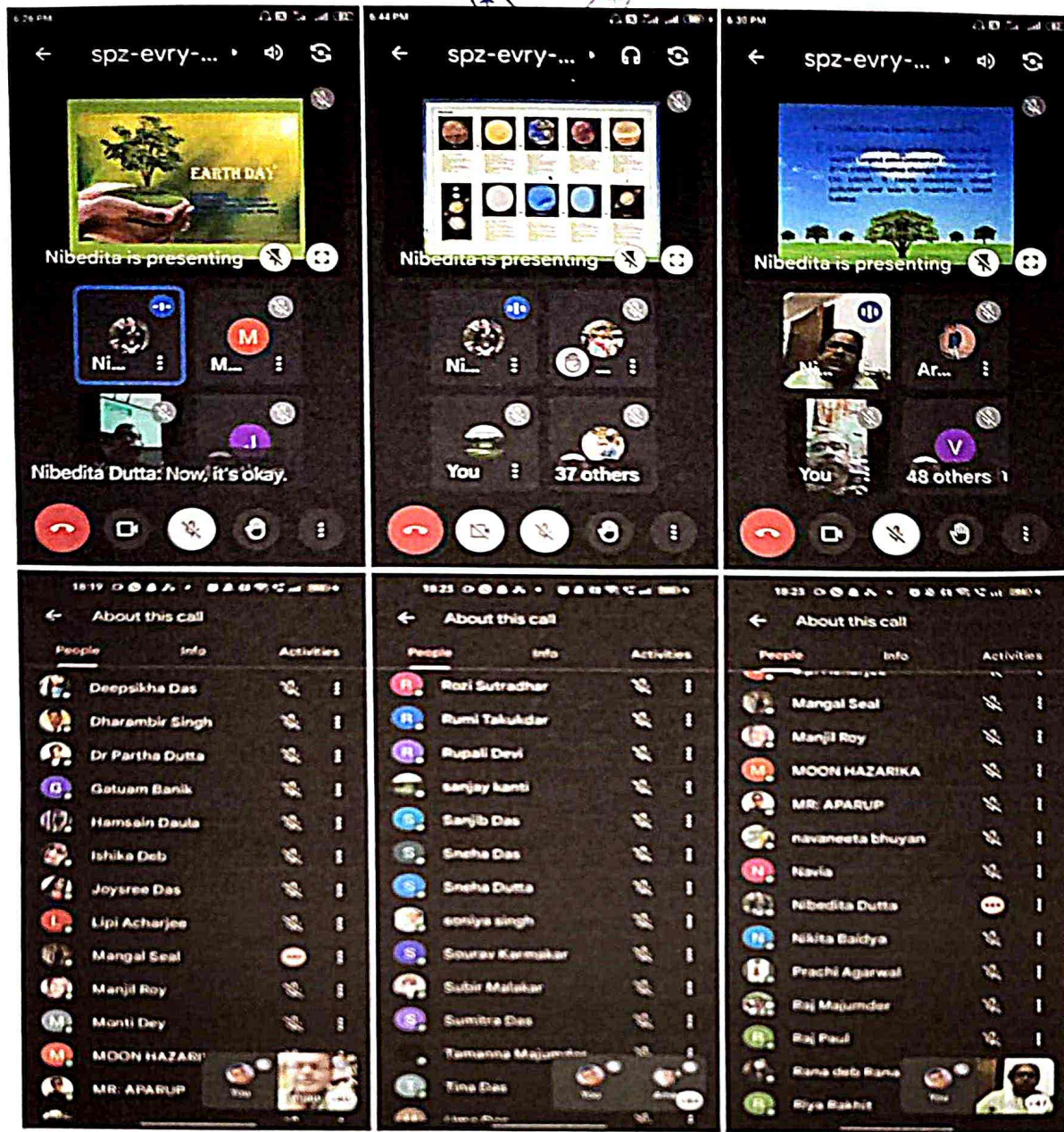
