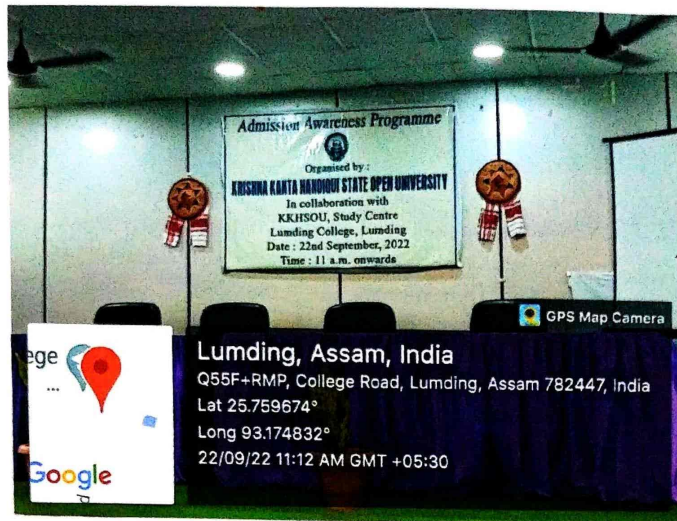


ADMISSION AWARENESS PROGRAMME BY KKHSOU

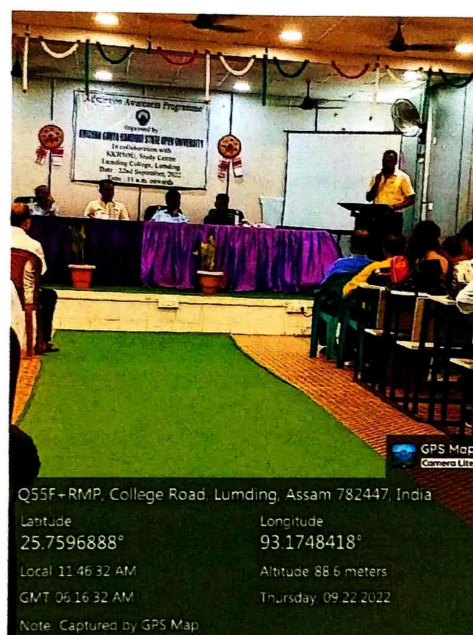

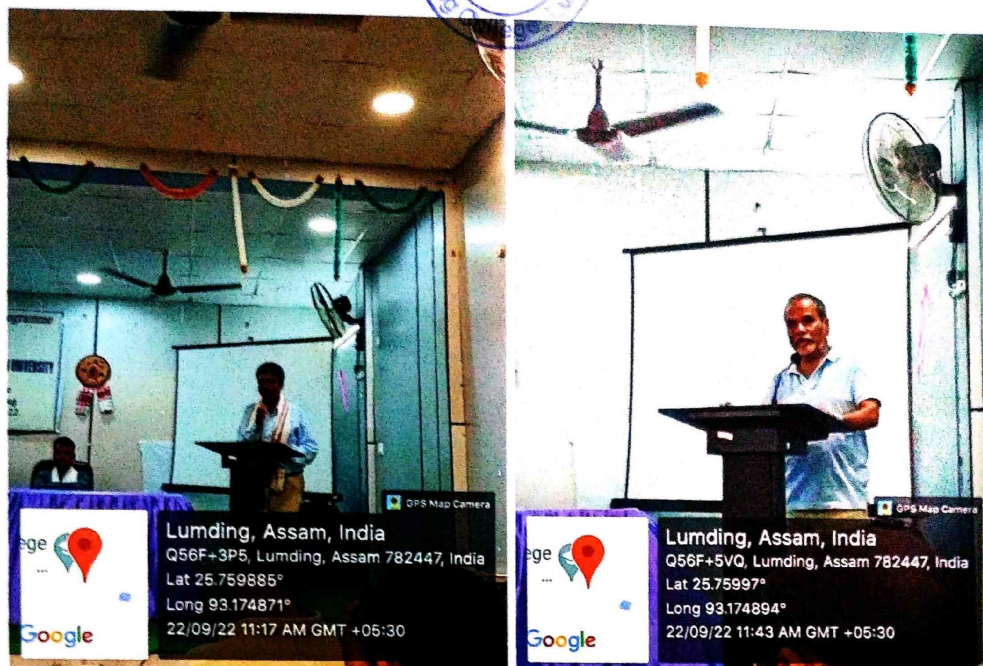
Felicitation of the esteemed members
