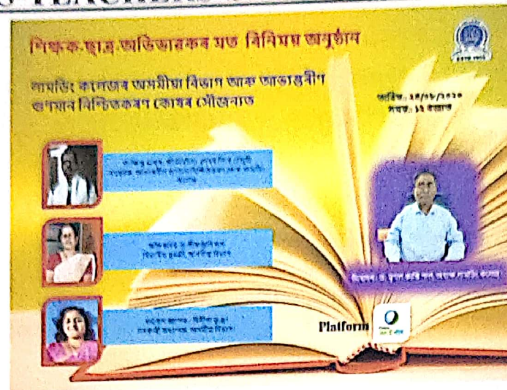


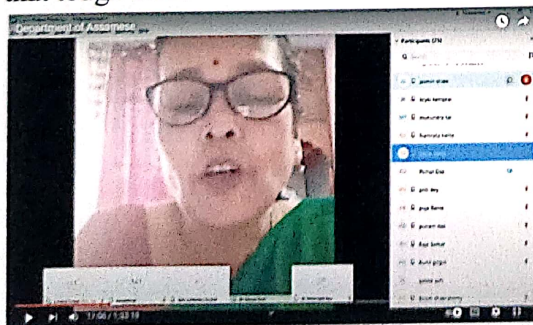
Report on

ONLINE PARENTS-TEACHERS-STUDENTS INTERACTIVE SESSION



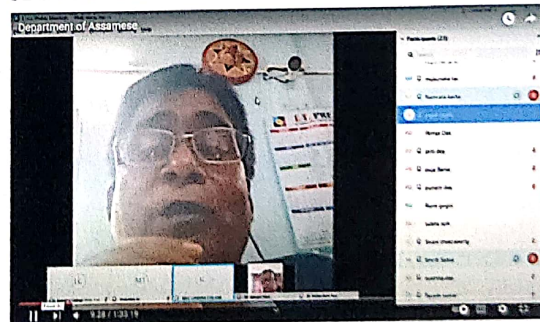
An online parents-teachers-students interactive session was organised by Department of Assamese, Lumding College in association with Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), Lumding College on August 24, 2020. 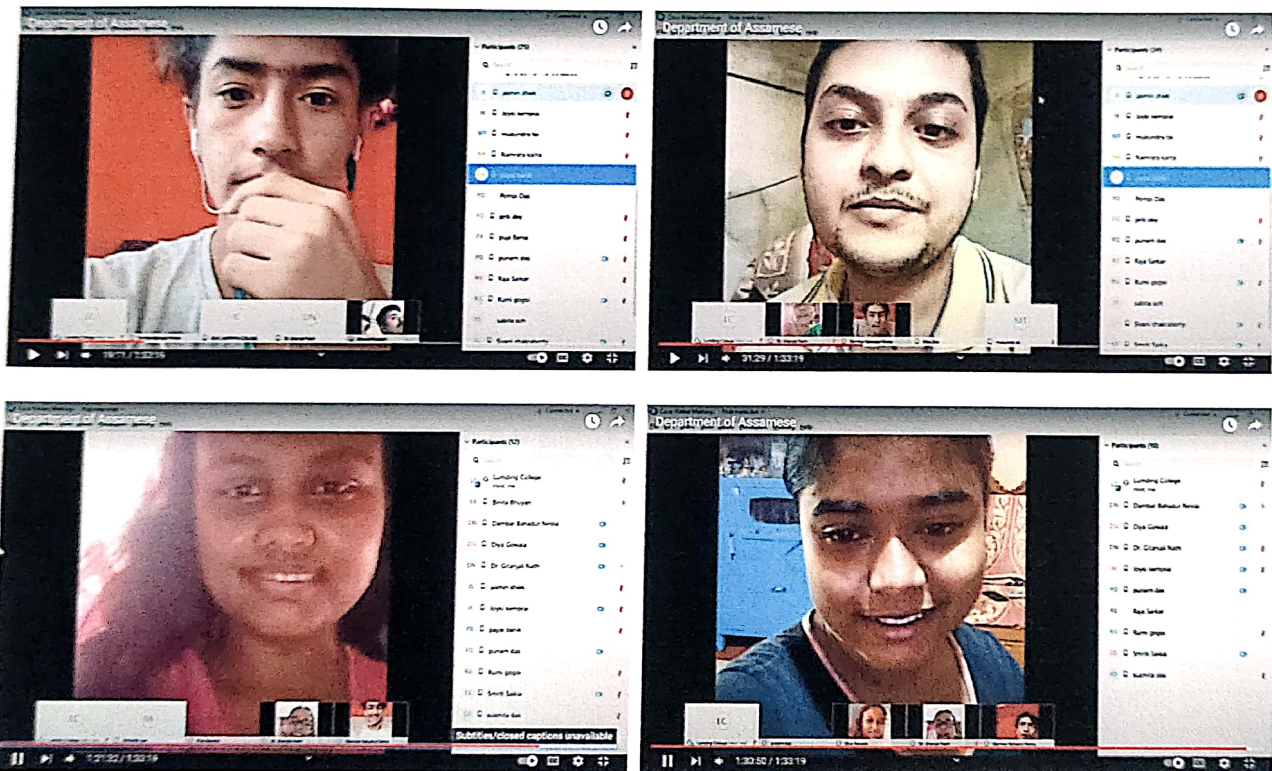


Picture: Dr. Mrinal K. Paul during his inaugural speech.

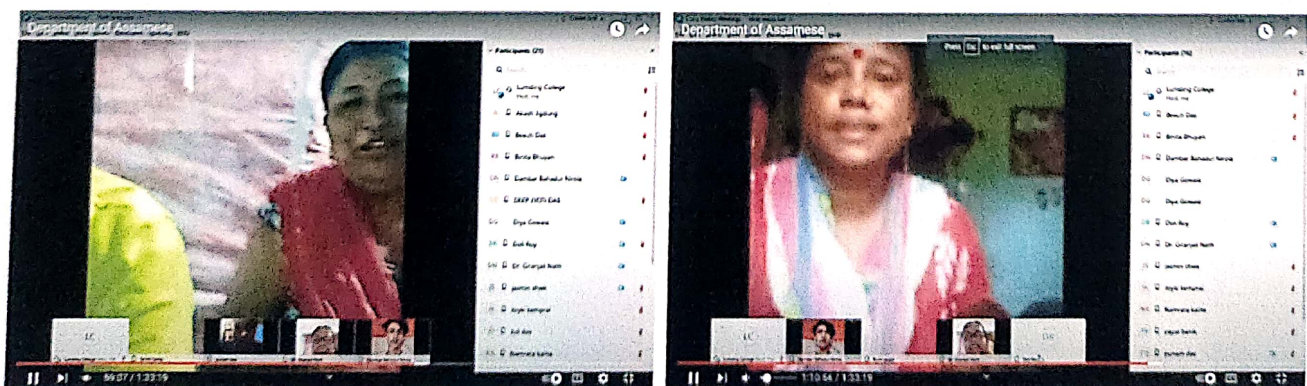
It was then students' and parents' turn to express their thoughts. Most students talked about network issues they faced while online classes and appreciated offline mode of examination for this reason. Parents, too,

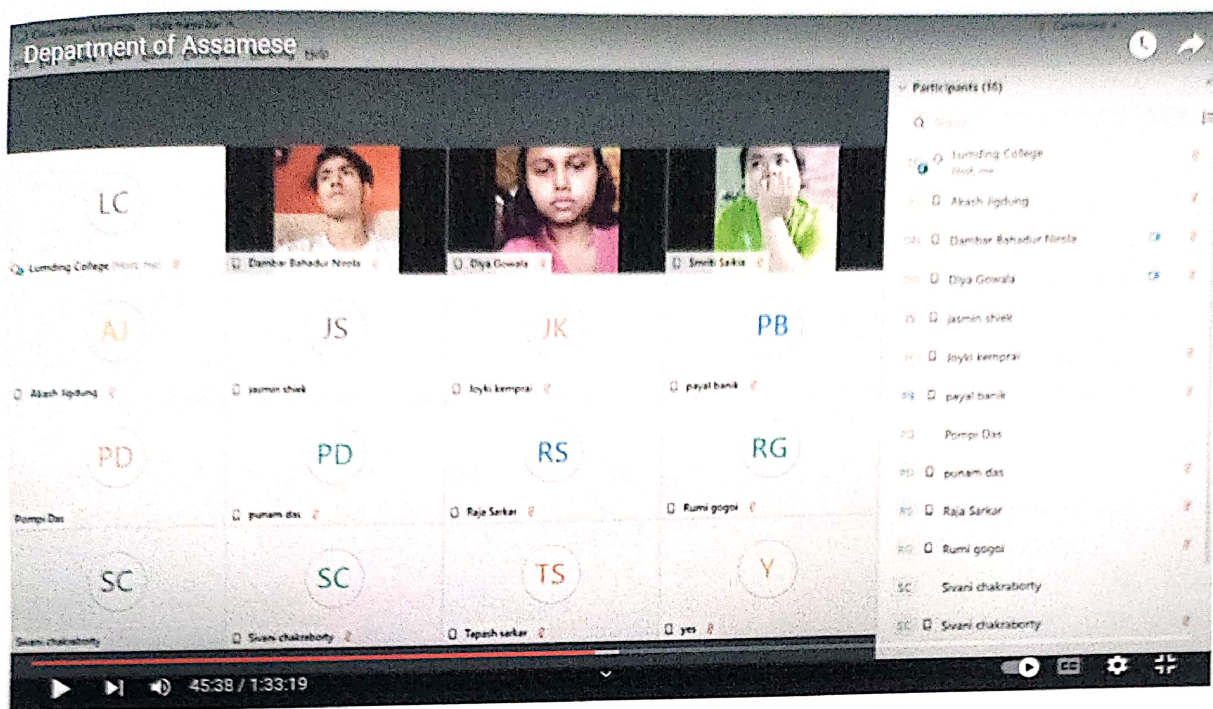


Picture: Some of students participating the program.
