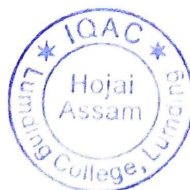


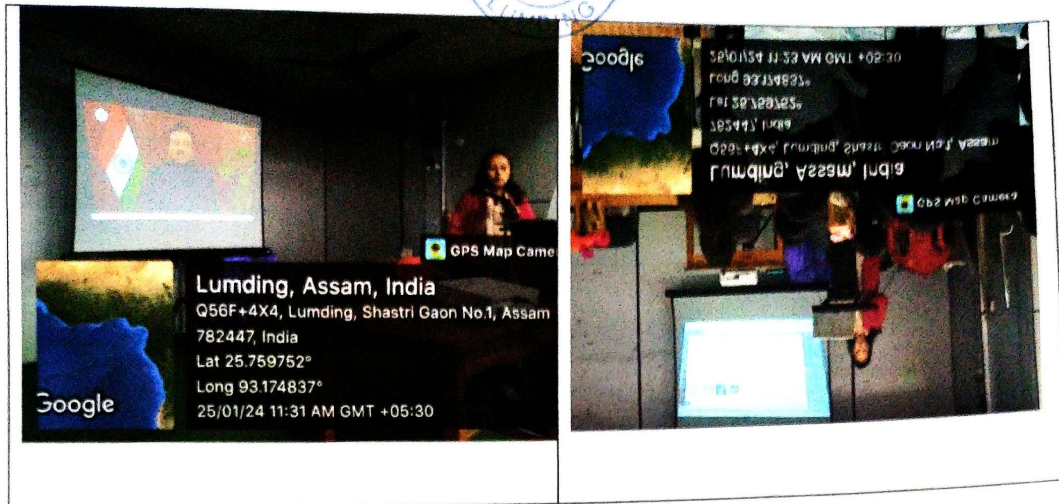


Report on Observance of National Voters Day
