India's first home minister Vallabhbhai Patel was dubbed "*Sardar*" (chief) for his leadership skills in leading the country through the struggle for independence and beyond but most notably during the integration of the princely states and also the India-Pakistan War of 1947. His birth anniversary is now celebrated as National Unity Day or Rashtriya Ekta Diwas. The National Unity Week will be held from October 25 to October 31, 2023, as part of the





“Meri Maati Mera Desh” campaign, which aims to honor the courageous freedom warriors who gave their lives in defense of our freedom and to propagate the message of national unity and the spirit of Rashtriya Ekta. As a part of the programme and as per the schedule that are given in the minutes, NSS and Extension Activity Cell, Lumding College organise special assembly on 31st October, 2023 Rastriya Ekta Diwas and National Unity Week. His deep awareness of the nation's socio-political context and his unwavering dedication to the values of social justice and democracy made him a priceless asset in the process of nation-building. He thanked briefly talked about Vallabhbhai Patel, his life and the importance of celebrating his birth anniversary. Dr. Uttam Das, HoD, Political Science also explained the role of Vallabhbhai Patel in the formation of Indian constitution and Vallabhbhai Patel's role in establishing unity among princely states. The programme ended with a Vote of Thanks by Mr. Anjan Paul where he thanked everyone for their presence.
