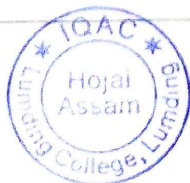


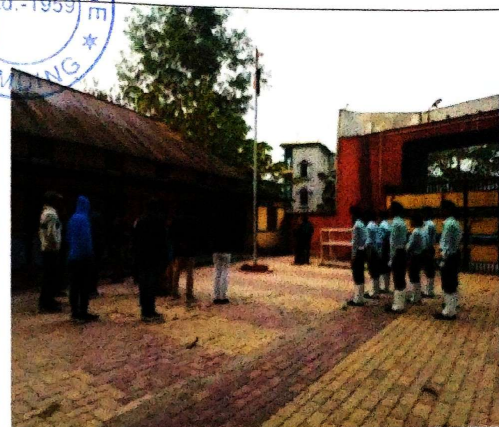
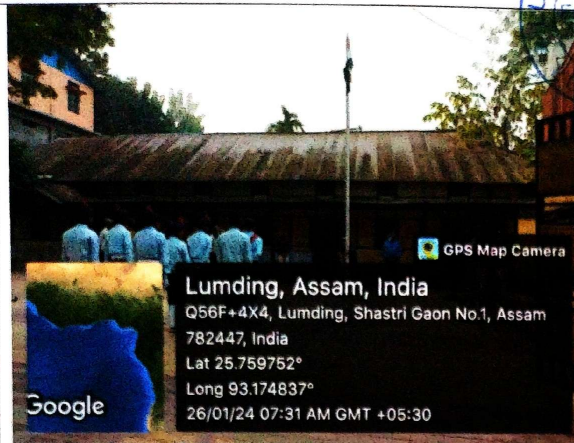
Report on Celebration of Republic Day

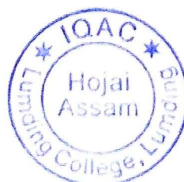
