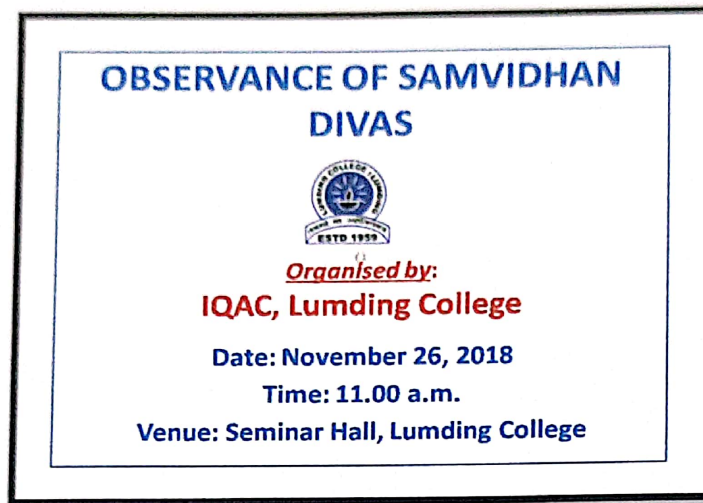




Observance of Samvidhan Divas - 2018



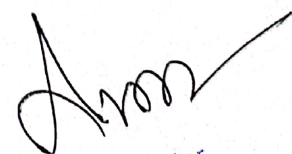
On 26th November, 2018, Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), Lumding College observed Samvidhan Divas (Constitution Day) at the college. A total of 50 participants including 14 teachers were present in the program. It started at 11.00 a.m. in the college seminar hall. The main objective of the day was to spread awareness on Indian constitution and to remember the Heros behind its existence. The programme started with a welcome note by Dr. Mrinal Kanti Paul, Principal, Lumding College. He recalled the contribution of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar in drafting of our Constitution. Next, Dr. Mandira Duttgupta, Head, Department of Political Science emphasized the importance of Constitution Day, the significance of its celebration and commemorated the people who contributed to the development of Indian constitution. He highlighted the basic differences of Indian constitution than that of other countries with examples indicating the prerequisites of the constitution such as societal, familial and individual needs.
