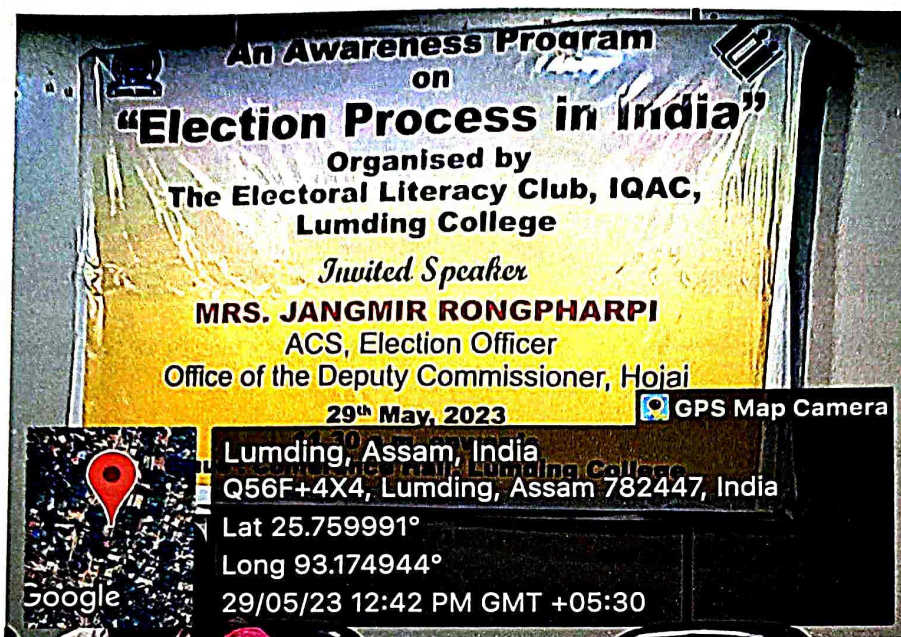




REPORT ON

AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON ELECTORAL PROCESS IN INDIA



An awareness programme on “Electoral Process in India” was organized by the Electoral Literacy Club, IQAC, Lumding College on the 29th of May, 2023. Mrs. Jangmir Rongpharpi, ACS, Election Officer at the office of the Deputy Commissioner, Hojai, had been invited as the speaker on the occasion, to share her knowledge and valuable insight on the topic. The programme commenced at 11:30 am at the conference hall of the college.

At the very onset, the invited speaker along with the Principal of the college, Dr. Mrinal Kanti Paul, the IQAC coordinator, Dr. Sanjay Kanti Das were invited over to the stage and asked to take their respective seats, followed by which they were felicitated with the assamese traditional gamusa by the students of the college. 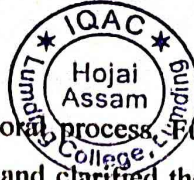
