About the HEI

Lumding College is situated in the heart of Lumding town in the district of Hojai in the state of Assam. It is one of the oldest colleges in this remote part of the country. The college was established on 14th August, 1959 by a group of visionary academicians, patriots and philanthropists who aspired for the growth of higher education in the small town of Lumding. Since its inception, the college had struggled through difficult phases of hardship to achieve its present status. The college was taken under the deficit system of grant-in-aid by the Govt. of Assam on 1st December, 1972. It was provincialized by the Govt. of Assam on 1st December, 2005.

Today, Lumding College offers Higher Secondary as well as Three Year Degree (TDC) courses in three streams: Arts, Science and Commerce. It is affiliated to Assam Higher Secondary Education Council (AHSEC) and Gauhati University (GU) respectively. Apart from these, it also offers some professional and self-financing courses. Today, it has an enrollment of more than 2000 students from diverse backgrounds who create a vibrant atmosphere in the college campus. The students have been producing remarkable results in academics as well as co-curricular activities with the guidance and encouragement of very dedicated faculty members. The college has also produced students who have managed to achieve top positions in the final examinations.

Lumding College was accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) with B+ grade in 2004 and in cycle-II, the College was re-accredited by the NAAC with B grade in 2018. The College is also certified as ISO 9001 and 14001. It is upgraded to Model Degree College by RUSA in 2019. It gives utmost importance to enhance the quality of higher education by considering the needs and expectations of each and every student. It has spacious Classrooms, well-equipped science Laboratories, a Language Lab, a rich Library with internet facilities, separate Departmental Library, free Wi-Fi facility, an AC Seminar Hall, a Central computer room, a Northeast Heritage Centre, a two-store Girls' hostel, well-furnished separate Common rooms for Boys and Girls and a Canteen with hygienic food. Adequate facilities for games and sports, amenity for safe drinking water and a vehicle shed. It is in the process of constructing smart classrooms for advanced teaching- learning process.

The fraternity of Lumding College also considers the aspirations of people who could not pursue higher education due to various reasons. It has opened a study centre of the K.K. Handique State Open University which offers degree programmes such as BA, B.Sc., B.Com., BBA and BCA in the Distance mode. It has also opened a contact centre of the Institute of Distance and Open Learning (IDOL), Gauhati University in the campus which helps in pursuing various post-graduate programme.

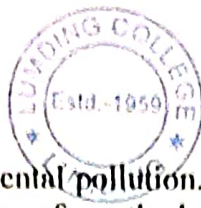
Special drive on Single use plastic

“The environment is the greatest luxury, let us unite to bring the changes in ourselves before it is too late to save the environment”.

With this pledge, our Lumding college has taken the initiatives to promote environment friendly practices in order to commemorate the initiative taken by the honorable Prime minister on mission LiFe so as to promote citizen level actions for conservation of environmental resources. Within the college premises, we have organised one awareness program on single use plastic or plastic free campus, e waste management and to avoid use of paper on 31st May 2023. As we all are very much aware about the fact that the plastics are hazardous element in the society posing a major threat to the livelihood of mankind and other in the world. The environment is getting polluted at the never before pace sparing no medium due to plastic, hence it is becoming a key responsibility of every citizen of our country not just to “Say no to plastic” but also to create awareness among the community as a whole to stop this pollution and leave behind the green and pollution place for our future generation. Prof. Parshu Upadhyaya head, department of history expressed his knowledge of experience to avoid the stakeholders about the less or no use of plastic in their livelihood activities. Prof. Upadhyay explained with the historical evidences that how the human anthropogenic activities are going on since long on earth surfaces resulting in environmental pollution and health hazard and he urged everyone to ever about their deeds and not to use or less use of plastic so is to have a healthy and Happy environment. Dr Satyajit Das Assistant Professor of Zoology, Lumding College has explained about the biodegradable, non-biodegradable wastes, single use plastic foods service ware, plastic bottles, banner etc. and their impact on the environment. Dr. Das spoke about the three ‘R Mantras’, Reduce, Recycle and Reuse to save the environment.

Special cleaning drive for plastic and e- waste management in College

Dr. Sanjay Kanti Das IQAC coordinator Lumding college Lumding highlighted about the electronic waste of the campuses and elaborated about the e-waste management systems and the new rules of e-wastes management 2022 that kicked in first April 2023. Dr..Das said that e-waste is a major concern in today’s world and is an environmental killer, its management is also of great concern. Dr. Das mentioned that informal processing of e-waste in developing countries can lead



to adverse human health effects and environmental pollution. He suggested about the process to collect e-waste, recover and recycle material by safe methods and suitable disposal techniques of e-waste to reduce its adverse impact on the environment. A team of about 45 members including teaching, non-teaching staffs and the students of Lumding College merged a drive in order to collect the e-wastes material within the campus so as to make it a clean and green environment.

No or less use of paper (Digital campus to avoid use of paper)

Dr. Sanghamitra Das (Bose), head of the department of Zoology and the coordinator of Environment and Climate Cell, IQAC, Lumding College had nicely elaborated about converting a paper based process into a paperless campus, which can improve operating efficiency and delivery especially in a document driving decision support system (DDSS). Dr. Das (Bose) added that in upcoming modern technical world, the office functions will bring about use of a less paper and will bring digitization and electronic record keeping systems. She also said that using less paper can save our organisations money and can also help with several environmental problems as it has been recorded that 42% of the trees harvested for industrial used are being utilised for making paper.

Bicycle rally on Mission LiFe activities

Protecting our environment is the foundation for sustaining our planet, community and economy. Our environment supports and houses our ecosystems allow them to grow and thrive. If we fail to protect our environment, we will put the life of humans, animals, plants and more at risk. Lumding college Lumding organised a bicycle rally starting from the college main gate to APTF second battalion Lumding south of about 5 km on 3rd June 2023 with an aim to promote the theme of save energy under mission LiFe. This bicycle rally has been organised to create awareness and to connect people in order to promote notion of a sustainable lifestyle by staying connected to nature. Prof. Anjan Paul, Assistant Professor, Department of Bengali and convener of NSS unit Lumding College address the students with the objective of mission LiFe and emphasized the need for eco-friendly lifestyle and to spread awareness and mass mobilization on Mission LiFe. Dr. Minal Kanti Paul, Principal Lumding college hailed the effort and said that the resident of the Lumding City who are now facing an increasing problem of traffic congestion and atmospheric pollution must consider the option of cycling for short distances. Students also express enthusiasm over the initiative and they took it as "Riding bicycle is always fun" and is also much simpler and easiest since it requires not fuel and easy on the pocket. During the rally the student participants chanted slogan "*Cycle Chalao Paribesh Bachao*" (Ride the bicycle to save the environment).

World Environment day has been observed in the seminar hall of the college campus on 5th June 2023 with an aim to increase public awareness of environmental challenges and encourage action. Dr. Mrinal Kanti Paul, Principal Lumding College addressed the participants about the theme of World Environment day 2023 which focus on solutions to plastic pollution under the campaign # BeatPlasticPollution and tried to inspiring positive change for most sustainable world. Dr. Nibedita Dutta, Head department of Geology, Lumding College, highlighted the LiFe Pledge

Dr. Dutta urged to the environmentally friendly and to live in a way which is not harmful to the environment. 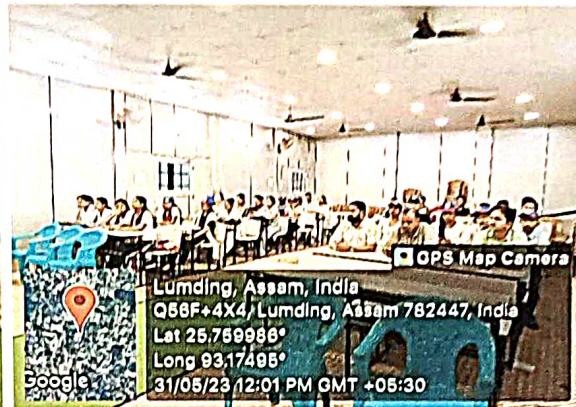
