

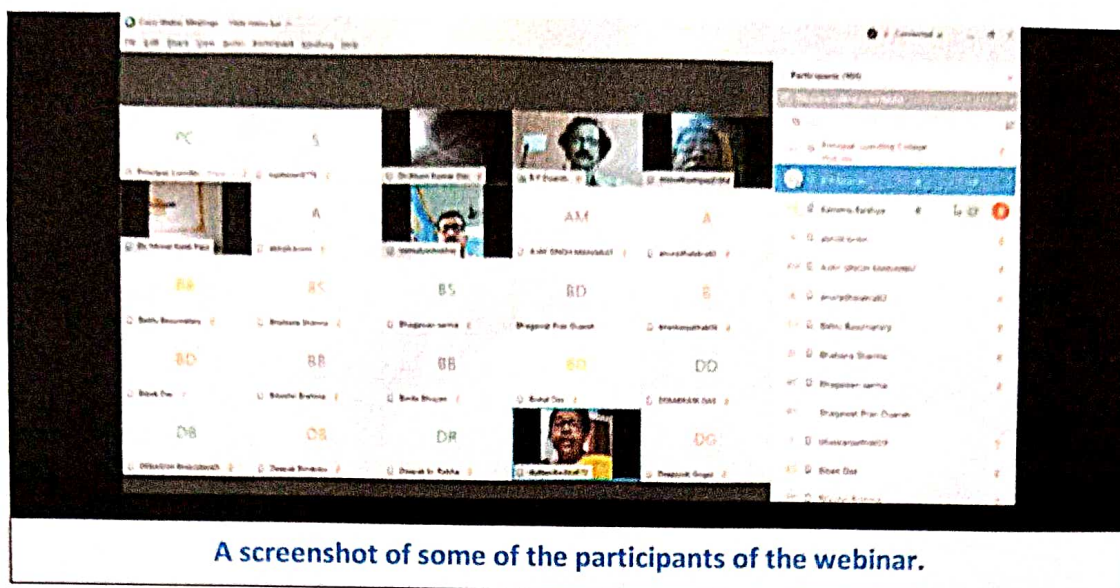


REPORT ON WEBINAR ON REMOTE SENSING AND ITS APPLICATION

On the 5th of August 2020 a national webinar on “Remote Sensing and its application” was organised by the department of Geology, Lumding College, in collaboration with IQAC, Lumding College, Lumding where in 1468 participants had registered themselves for the webinar. The platform used for the virtual meeting was Cisco webex. Dr. Nibedita Dutta, Head of the department of Geology, Lumding College hosted and chaired the entire session. The resource person for this webinar was Prof. Bhagawat Pran Duarah, professor of the department of Geological Sciences, Gauhati University. He initially started his career at Assam Remote Sensing Application Centre (ARSAC) from 10th Aug 1989 till 7th Aug 1996. After that, in the same year he joined the department of Geological Sciences, Gauhati University, Guwahati. Prof Daruah was one of the key person for preparing the Hydrogeomorphological Mapping of Assam from the first Indian Remote Sensing Satellite (IRS) data during 1989-90 at 1:250,000 scale at district level at ARSAC under Rajiv Gandhi Drinking Water Technology Mission. He has also completed several research projects and published research articles on geomorphology, seismo-tectonics, river erosion, environmental impact of hydropower projects in the country and also in Bhutan on the basis of remote sensing data. Prof. Daruah has published about 60 research articles in both national and international journals. Seven research scholars have achieved Ph.D while five others are pursuing their Ph.D research under him. He is life-member of several professional bodies.

As the webinar began, Dr. N. Dutta requested Dr. Mrinal Kanti Paul, principal of Lumding College to deliver the inaugural speech and Mr. Nirmalya Shekhar Singha Chowdhury, Associate Professor of Botany department and IQAC coordinator, Lumding College to give a welcome speech. After their brief speeches, Dr. Dutta invited Prof. Daruah to start the session where he spoke on remote sensing and its applications. After the session ended, he interacted with the participants and addressed their queries. As the discussions ended, Dr. Sujata Sen, Associate Professor, department of Geology, Lumding College concluded the session by delivering vote of thanks. The session was very informative and enriching for all the participants. The link for the feedback form was shared in the Whatsapp group where all the participants were included and after receiving the feedback form from each one of them, an e-certificate of attendance in the webinar was mailed to them in their respective e-mails.
